Arts, Culture and Community Facilities



- 1. Expansion of Teen Space & Technology Upgrade at the Woodside Library**
 – 54-22 Skillman Avenue (Woodside) (\$150,000)
 Expanding the meeting room in the teen space at the Woodside Library, and outfitting the room with technology.

Education



- 2. Water Fountain Installation at P.S. 112**
 – P.S. 112 (Dutch Kills) (\$80,000)
 Students do not have regular access to fresh drinking water. The school is in need of 8 (eight) water fountains.
- 3. Mobile Laptops and Carts for Schools**
 – Throughout District 26 (\$700,000)
 Project will give mobile laptops and carts to Academy of American Studies, Aviation H.S., P.S. 12, 111, 112, 76, 166.
- 4. Playground Upgrades at P.S. 111 and 152**
 – P.S. 111 (LIC) and P.S. 152 (LIC) (\$500,000)
 The playground upgrades will include general repainting and safety improvements at both schools.
- 5. Bathroom Repairs and Upgrades for Schools**
 – P.S. 112 (LIC), P.S. 12 (Woodside), P.S. 199 (Sunnyside) (\$450,000)
 Essential repairs, upgrades, and efficiency enhancements of 2 (two) restroom facilities needed per school.
- 6. Auditorium Upgrades at P.S. 166 & P.S. 111**
 – P.S. 166 (Astoria) and P.S. 111 (LIC) (\$300,000)
 P.S.166 needs upgrades to improve the school's performance space. P.S.111 is in need of new seats in the auditorium.

Housing



- 7. Grounds Restoration at Ravenswood Houses**
 – Ravenswood Houses (Astoria/LIC) (\$500,000)
 Restoration focused on storm management and new drainage methods to avoid water pooling on sidewalks and street.
- 8. Soundproofing Ravenswood Community Center**
 – Ravenswood Houses (Astoria/LIC) (\$500,000)
 Installation of soundproofing for the audio recording room at the Ravenswood Community Center.
- 9. Playground Spray Shower Upgrade in Queensbridge**
 – Queensbridge Houses (LIC) (\$425,000)
 New spray shower is needed on 10th Street so children can keep cool and safe in the summer within their own playground.

- 10. Kitchen Renovations at the Queensbridge Houses**
 – Queensbridge Houses (LIC) (\$650,000)
 Upgrades to the kitchen at the Queensbridge Senior Center.

- 11. Sitting Area Rebuild at Queensbridge**
 – Queensbridge Houses (LIC) (\$425,000)
 Rebuild rundown sitting area on 10th Street for family and senior enjoyment and safety.

- 12. Gardening Improvements at Woodside Houses**
 – Woodside Houses (Woodside) (\$400,000)
 Improvement of gardens and building pathways along Woodside Houses.

Parks and Recreation



- 13. Gordon Triangle Green Street Upgrade**
 – 44th Drive & Vernon Boulevard (LIC) (\$800,000)
 New benches, improved lighting, and additional plantings would offer visitors a pleasant green space to enjoy.
- 14. Sixteen Oaks Grove Renovation**
 – 37th Ave. between 14th & 21st Streets (LIC) (\$1,000,000)
 This will fund new greenery, the resurfacing of cracked walkways and bench replacements for this neighborhood park.
- 15. Shade Canopy for Hunters Pt. South Park Playground**
 – Center Blvd. bet. 50th Ave. & 54th Ave. (LIC) (\$800,000)
 Install a permanent structure by the children's playground to provide shade for children, parents and park-goers.
- 16. BBQ Area Picnic Tables at Rainey Park**
 – Vernon Blvd. between 33rd Rd. & 34th Ave. (LIC) (\$550,000)
 Funding will provide BBQ areas with clean and convenient amenities like picnic tables and benches.

Transit



- 17. Pedestrian Safety Improvements**
 – 41st Avenue and 28th Street (LIC) (\$700,000)
 A half curb extension on a corner of an intersection used by pedestrians, students and staff from nearby schools.
- 18. Bus Time Countdown Clocks**
 – Throughout District 26 (\$200,000)
 This addresses the need to provide groups that cannot rely on or utilize the subway system with in-time bus information.
